East Markham Village Hall Friday 3rd May 6.30pm



The BBC Radio 4 topical radio show is being broadcast live from East Markham giving you the chance to air your question to an 'expert' panel with all the country listening. Normally, four to six questions chosen by the producer are included in the actual broadcast. One of the stringent and unchanging rules of Any Questions? is that the panel never sees the questions in advance; the panellists hear them for the first time at the same moment the audience in the hall and at home does.

Doors open 6.30pm. The audience is invited to submit written questions at the venue and be seated by 7.15pm. The warm-up begins at 7.30pm and the live broadcast commences at 8.02pm.

HUGS PARISH COUNCIL NEWS

At the last Parish Council meeting, District Councillor Ant Coulte reported on the recent demolition at Cottam Power Station. He had recently run a consultation on what people wanted on the site once it had been cleared, and a nature reserve was the top ask.

The Parish Council has decided not to purchase the car park opposite the church at Headon but is still hoping to replace the recycling bin there.

There have been no applications for the position of Clerk so the post will be re-advertised.

The next meeting of the Parish Council has been moved to Monday 8th April 2024 to stop it clashing with Easter. It will be at 7pm in the Village Hall at Headon. Members of the public can attend and ask questions at the beginning of the meeting.
