Answers: It's all down to what scheduled time the trains are due to arrive. We know they are 20 minutes apart but if the northbound train comes in on the hour ie 0900, 0920, 0940 etc but the southbound train comes in at 4 minutes past ie 0904, 0924, 0944 etc then if Tom arrives at a random time there will only be 12 minutes in each hour when a southbound train will arrive next, meaning that is most likely he will catch a train going north.
