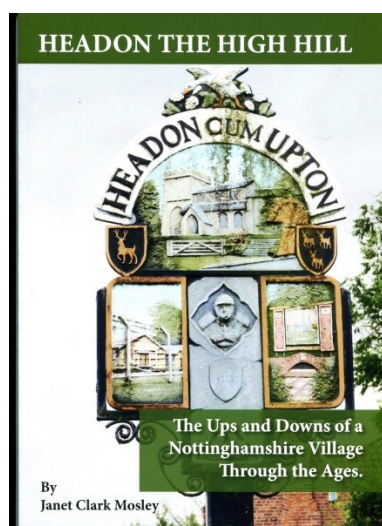

An update from Headon-cum-Upton, Grove & Stokeham Parish Council

Issues continue to be raised regarding the flooding at Grove, and at Westfields, Upton. The Parish Council is working to find solutions with the support of Nottinghamshire County Councillor John Ogle, and the newly appointed Flooding Officer at Bassetlaw District Council.

We are sure you will join the Parish Council in thanking Suzanne for all her hard work in the village keeping things maintained and tidy. She works for the Parish Council, as part of the Nottinghamshire County Council lengthsman's scheme. If you have any areas that you feel may need attention please let the Parish Council know by contacting the Parish Clerk at headonpc@gmail.com

To help residents keep abreast on local information the Parish Council is working on publishing a website, which we hope will be launched in the next few months. We'd be grateful if residents have any photos or items they'd like to share with us that we could use, or suggestions of what they'd like to see on it.

On Monday 20th January the Parish Council set their precept for the upcoming year 2025/26 at £10838. This equates to £65.37 per year for a Council Tax band D property. A slight increase of 4.11% from last year.

The Parish Council is working with a local Recycling Company to have recycle bins in each village, which we hope will be put to good use. We'll keep you updated on where they'll be located, so watch this space!

Just a reminder that each village has a defibrillator located and accessible for anyone that might need to use them.

The survey about St Peter's church which was mentioned in the November newsletter, will be delivered to every household during late January/early February. This is to gather villagers' views on the future of St Peter's. Please can you take a look at it and respond as soon as possible but by 28th February at the latest. Many thanks!

National Grid Electricity Transmission Upgrade

The Parish Council has been contacted by National Grid regarding its plans to build a new electricity transmission line between a new substation to the north of Hull at Creyke Beck in the East Riding of Yorkshire and a new substation at High Marnham in Nottinghamshire. National Grid currently proposes a possible route through our parish.

The proposed upgrade is required to increase the capability of the electricity transmission network between the north of England and the Midlands and will facilitate the connection of new offshore wind that is planned to connect in the area in the next decade. The proposals are part of The Great Grid Upgrade – the largest overhaul of the grid in generations.

North Humber to High Marnham is a Nationally Significant Infrastructure Project which means an application for a Development Consent Order will need to be prepared and submitted to the Planning Inspectorate. Ultimately the Secretary of State will be responsible for making the final decision on the application.

Between June and July 2023, they held a Stage 1 (non-statutory) consultation for North Humber to High Marnham where they presented their early-stage proposals, followed by a localised non-statutory consultation between July and August 2024. They are now preparing to hold a Stage 2 (statutory) consultation on their detailed proposals in 2025 and have been engaging with local authorities to gather feedback on their draft Statement of Community Consultation (SoCC).

The Parish Council has contacted National Grid to ask them to meet and talk with Councillors and residents about the proposals. We will let residents know if they are willing to do this, and when the meeting will be.

Repairs to St. Peter's Church

Bridgett Conservation Ltd. has now been appointed to carry out some essential repairs to the church building. This will include the replacement or painting and repair of some of the gutters and downpipes, as well as some minor repairs to the tower and nave roof and some repointing of the masonry.

Scaffolding will be erected in mid February and work is expected to last for about a month. During this time the church will still be accessible to anyone who wishes to go into the building.
