## An update from Headon-cum-Upton, Grove & Stakeham Parish Council

### North Humber to High Marnham Power Line

As you may be aware National Grid is consulting on its latest proposal for the route of this power line. Unlike the two previous consultations in 2023 and 2024 this is a statutory consultation which is the final stage before the submission of an application for a Development Control Order (effectively planning permission for projects deemed to have significance for national infrastructure).

The proposed route runs just to the west of Rampton Hospital, crosses the Headon-Stokeham road near Magpie Farm and the Upton to East Drayton road just to the east of Fields Farm. ## Dorrie's Story

Janet Landon has kindly provided this further story to add to her recent village history compilation.

Thank you to everyone who has bought a copy of my book, Headon: High Hill. I have been delighted with the interest that it has aroused and have been asked to send copies far and wide. It has been so interesting to connect with people whose families lived here long ago and to read their stories. Too late for the book, sadly!



I would like to share this lovely story with you. It concerns the old school in Headon Park, which really is a magical place. It has always reminded me of a fairy tale cottage though without the wolf or the bears! Knowing that the lady of the manor used to give a Red Riding Hood cloak to each little girl who went to this school only enhances this image.

Here's Dorrie's story which comes from a lady who lives in Leeds: "My grandmother's maiden name was Dorothy Booth (childhood pet names Dorrie or Dolly). She lived into her late 90s, and often told me stories about her childhood in Headon.

Her family lived in the Old Schoolhouse in Headon Park during the First World War period, where her father was a Forester. It must have been a marvellous place to grow up. My grandmother certainly had many wonderful memories of playing there, and of its wildlife and her beloved horse called Khaki!

Her mum Sarah is buried at Headon Church, and her big brother John (Private J. Booth) is also commemorated on the Roll of Honour plaque inside the Church. John fought in WW1 for the duration and survived, received a medal at Mons and went on to be mentioned for his bravery in delivering dispatches under heavy shell fire at the Somme.

Dorrie went on to become a nursery nurse at Babworth Rectory until her marriage.

*"Back then there used to be lots of bluebells and primroses growing there, and when I was little I'd gather a big, big bunch of primroses and beautiful blue and white violets. Mother would put them in a shoebox, with all moss and leaves round them, for Father to put onto the train for London. He'd let my sister there know what train they'd be on and she would be waiting for it to come in, to pick up this box full of fresh flowers from home."*  
Dorothy Maude Booth 1905-2002 (excerpt from a family recording of her reminiscences in 1999)

My grandmother was the youngest of 9 children, so her sister in London was by that time already grown up and married to a banker, but she did still miss her family, Headon and country life. Dorrie would go to stay with her there sometimes, and though she found London fascinating, apparently Dorrie didn't think it was a patch on Headon and couldn't wait to be home!"
