Don't Forget Voter ID required to vote at Polling Stations on 2 May

All voters will need to show an accepted form of photo ID when voting at a Polling Station in the upcoming Combined Mayoral Authority and Police and Crime Commissioner elections.

All accepted forms of ID must include your photo and be suitably secure, such as a passport, driving licence, bus pass or blue badge. If you have an accepted form of ID, but the date has expired, you'll still be able to use it if the photo is still a good likeness.
