Parish Council News

Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 7th March 2016

Council Members

Parish Council members are Jonathan Wallwin (chairman), David Landon (vice-chairman), Eric Briggs, Chris Holliland, Janet Landon, Beatrice McGlen, Alun McKiernon, John Mosley, Ben Wielgus and Fred Withers. Our District Councillor is Teresa Critchley and our County Councillor is John Ogle.

Snowplough

The snowplough has been inspected again recently and a fault has now been fixed. Special thanks to Sean Whelan of Upton for carrying out the repair. The snowplough will be collecting dust until springtime as we are not allowing any more snow this year!

Grants to Village Organisations

Parish council grants are given annually to the 3 churches and the village hall, within the parish; they are budgeted for and given in April each year to the 4 beneficiaries without the need for application. It is a statutory power of the parish council to grant funding in this way.

Any grants outside of these would require a letter of application explaining why the funds are required and would be considered on individual merit at a parish council meeting. An allowance is not included in the budget for any other grants.

The grants to the churches are for churchyard maintenance. The grant to the village hall is to assist with its upkeep and running costs.

It was decided that these annual grants remain in place and that we ask for feedback as to how the funds are to be used when we issue the cheques, and that any other grant applications be accompanied with details of how the money is intended to be used so that careful consideration can be given at a parish council meeting.

Grant for Planting Scheme at Grove

DCllr. Teresa Critchley is to apply for £200 on our behalf in order to fund a planting scheme at Grove war memorial. Six volunteers have come forward to carry out the work involved.

Headon Village Notice Board

The village notice board is now located in the bus shelter.

Neighbourhood Plan (NP)

Further information has been sought to ascertain the amount of work involved and the benefits that could be gained from having a NP in place. We have looked at NP's for other villages and have decided to go ahead with producing one for Headon, Upton, Grove and Stokeham subject to securing the necessary funding. Special Meetings, Public Consultations and Public Presentations will follow in due course, please keep an eye out for advertisements as everyone's input is essential to the success of this venture.

Public Forum Session

The 10 minute Public Forum session is at 7.30pm prior to the parish council meeting giving residents the chance to speak to members. Whilst you are welcome to watch the whole meeting, you are reminded that from 7.40pm when the parish council meeting has started proper, any discussion or interruptions from the public is not allowed.

We ask that you please remain quiet while the parish council meeting is in progress. Any interruptions or joining in with our discussions cannot be allowed. Do you have any memories or stories about Headon Camp, from the days when it was a POW and displaced persons camp? Or would you like to hear other people's stories?



On Friday, April 22nd Kevin Murphy will come to the village hall to give a talk about Headon Camp and to seek more information from local residents who may have stories or mementoes to share. Kevin's research is based on the testimony of some from each group of occupants - Italians, Germans and Ukrainians/Displaced Persons of Eastern Europe

He will share his findings in a one hour talk and hopes people from Headon and its locality will have more to add. Every farm in the area would almost certainly have used POWs.

Nottinghamshire Recycling Centres

From 1st April 2016, Nottinghamshire County Council, in an attempt to stop people coming from out of county to use its recycling centres, are introducing a registration system for residents wishing to use its 12 sites (including the Retford Hallcroft site). The registration system will require anyone using these sites to have completed an online application through the Council's self portal or telephone the Customer Service Centre and assign access rights to a maximum of 2 vehicles per address. If the registration number of the vehicle you use when visiting a recycling centre has not been registered, you will not be allowed to use the recycling centre. To register on-line go to:
