Parish Council News

Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 19th January 2015

High Speed Broadband

Cllr. B.Wielgus reported that the rollout is ahead of schedule and further funds are being released to ensure it stays on track. The villages are now scheduled for October 2015 to March 2016.

Bassetlaw DC Part Night Lighting Scheme (midnight to 5.30am switch off)

The effectiveness and consequences of the lighting scheme has been under discussion since the last meeting and at the public forum. Reasons for and against the scheme were heard and it was decided that the best way to determine whether the scheme is welcomed by residents was to put it to the vote.

Parish Council Budget 2015/16

A draft parish council budget based on figures similar to this year's and last year's income and expenditure was presented to members for consideration with the addition of an increase to church grants and the clerk's salary.

It was proposed at the last meeting to increase the precept in order to set aside money for projects which have been discussed and approved but require funding, members agreed that maybe this could be given more consideration over the next 12 months and be decided upon for the 2016/17 budget. Residents will be consulted for their opinions over the coming months prior to the parish council making any decisions. Members approved the draft budget as presented for 2015/16, setting a precept this year which will not impact on residents.

Police

PC Bailey attended the meeting and reported 2 recent oil thefts at Headon and Upton.

He also offered the year end figures and assured members that the reduced lighting scheme has not resulted in increased crime.

Neighbourhood Policing

PC Bailey informed members that it is probable that policing of the villages will become the responsibility of the Police Community Support Officers (PCSO), allowing PCs to concentrate on more problematic areas and town centres. Members felt that this raises concerns about inadequate neighbourhood policing. Cllr. John Ogle suggested that the parish council makes representations to the Police & Crime Commissioner and the Notts Police Chief Constable, which the Parish Council agreed to do.

Highways

Notification of Works from Notts CC – 7am 9th March to 8pm 13th March 2015 - Temporary prohibition of driving – Carriageway resurfacing works – Grove Road, Grove, from its junction with Wood Lane (South Leverton) for a distance of 1575m in a south westerly direction.

Street Lighting in Headon and Upton

At the January Parish Council Meeting, a discussion was held regarding the hours of operation of the street lights in the parish.

At present, street lights in the villages are controlled via light sensors but are programmed to switch off during the hours of midnight to 5am. This was instigated by Bassetlaw District Council in order to save money; cut carbon emissions; and reduce light pollution. Their policy has changed so that individual villages can now make their own decision.

The Parish Council has been approached by a resident to consider reinstating lighting throughout the night to improve safety and reduce the potential risk of crime.

Parish Councillors have received representations from those in favour of continuing the current operation and from those who would like to see the lights turned back on permanently throughout the night.

As a result the Parish Council has decided to gauge the opinion of the villages via a referendum below. The result of the vote will be discussed at the next meeting on the 2nd March.

The crime statistics both before and after the reduced lighting scheme was instigated are outlined in the Parish Council report on page 2.
