## Parish Council News

### Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2013

**Speeding Issues – Community Speedwatch** – PC Bailey reported that up to 18<sup>th</sup> May, 184 vehicles have been caught exceeding the speed limit. Letters have been sent to vehicle owners and none have been challenged, reassuring the speedwatch team that their results are correct. Some enforcement action has been taken by the police and this is ongoing. Several sites have been monitored and the team have been out as early as 6.30am in order to monitor works traffic. The Speedwatch team have now provided up-to-date information and by 6<sup>th</sup> June 257 speeding vehicles had been logged. Of these 65% were recorded at speeds up to 40 mph and almost all the rest were travelling between 40 and 50 mph, only 3 vehicles were travelling at over 50 mph.

The Council is particularly concerned about Thorpe Street/Yew Tree Road because the only 30 mph sign on this road is on Thorpe Street. There are 30 mph signs on all the roads into Upton and at the top of Greenspotts Lane and these limits continue to apply along Yew Tree Road. However, there is a tendency for drivers of vehicles joining Yew Tree Road from Upton and from Church Street in Headon to think that because it looks as though they are leaving the village they are also leaving the 30 mph limit, even though there are no signs indicating a different speed limit. The Council would therefore like to see some signage on Yew Tree Road that indicates to drivers that they are still in a 30 mph limit.

Some suggestions made by members of the public and council members have included the introduction of 30mph repeater signs, interactive speed signs and 30 stickers on wheelie bins. An on-site meeting with Nottinghamshire County Council Highways has been arranged to discuss options available.

**Broadband Speed Project** – it was reported that due to additional funding becoming available, Notts CC are delaying their announcements on the rollout of high speed broadband. Meanwhile, the Defra funding application is still in progress in case we are not selected.

**Highways** – an on-site meeting with County Council Highways was due to take place on 7<sup>th</sup> June to discuss all the issues of concern associated with the section of road from Woodbeck to Dog Kennel Hill and beyond.

**Next Meeting** – Monday 1<sup>st</sup> July at 7.30pm at Headon-cum-Upton Village Hall.
