Roadside Verges



The Notified Road Verge scheme run by Nottinghamshire County Council since 1979 is aimed at maintaining the biodiversity and interest of some of the best verges in the county. Four of these are in Bassetlaw of which one, at Westfields on the Upton to Eaton Road, is described as botanically one of the richest in the county. These verges receive carefully timed cuts and, importantly, the clippings are removed to prevent the build-up of thatch and nutrients that allow the coarser nettles, brambles, goosegrass and hogweed to take over. The photographs on the right above show cranesbill, yellow vetch and knapweed flowering, along with meadowsweet coming into bud. The middle photo is the post indicating that this verge is managed by NCC. The left picture shows the verge just two days later, after unauthorised cutting on Tuesday 23rd June, and clearly shows how the clippings smother everything that is left. The Senior Nature Conservation Officer, Nick Crouch, is concerned about the mismanagement of these important reservoirs of wild flowers and would be pleased to hear if anyone saw them being cut and to provide further information on the scheme and the management of these verges.

Casual Vacancy

High Speed Broadband

Upton now has faster broadband and it has just gone live in the last few days. The speed tests give a speed of between 12Mbps and 30Mbps. It was 0.5Mbps before which shows a significant improvement. The broadband site for Notts confirms that Upton is live and many parts of Headon have roll out shortly, some of the more remote houses may have to wait until October to see if they'll be included in the Phase 2 roll out. Grove is due for installation between October 2015 and March 2016.

Grove DN22 0RJ - October 2015 and March 2016

Grove DN22 0RL - October 2015 and March 2016 - Many but not all of the properties in the postcode will gain access to fibre broadband

Headon DN22 0PB - May be included in Phase 2. Check back in Oct 2015

Headon DN22 0RD - January 2015 and June 2015

Upton DN22 0RA - Certain premises will be served by works provisionally planned to take place between January 2015 and June 2015 with others planned for March 2016 onward

Headon DN22 0RQ - January 2015 and June 2015

Headon DN22 0PA - January 2015 and June 2015. Some but not all of the properties in the postcode will gain access to fibre broadband

Stokeham DN22 0LB - May be included in Phase 2. Check back in Oct 2015

Transparency Code for Smaller Authorities

New legislation requires that from July 2015, all parish councils are required to upload specific information regarding members, meetings and finances to a website which can then be accessed by members of the public. The parish council has sent the required information and is presently awaiting confirmation that their link is live.
