Notes from the Meeting held on Monday 6th June 2011

Parish Council Vacancies

As there are still two vacancies at Grove, we ask you to please contact the clerk or Cllr. Jonathan Wallwin if you are interested in becoming a parish council member. Your main commitment is to attend 10 evening meetings per year and to be a contact for residents between meetings. The level of involvement outside of this commitment is purely dependent on your own interests.

Severe Winter Weather

The Parish Council has now taken delivery of the snow plough. It has been tested out on the machinery it will be connected to and the council members are very pleased with the purchase. The blade is substantially made and is expected to last for many years. The blade will be kept in storage within the parish and is ready for action.

Road Sweeping

It was noted that the roads in Headon are ready for a sweep. This will be requested and hopefully a response will follow.

Grass Cutting

The height of grass at road junctions and on corners throughout the parish is becoming a concern as it becomes a hazard to motorists whose view is somewhat restricted. A grass cut will be requested, at least at these problem locations, and it is hoped that the cut will be carried out in the very near future.

Solar Panels – Headon Village Hall

A planning application was received for consideration by the council, to install solar panels on the roof of the village hall. Members thought this was a very good idea, providing free energy to the community centre.

Audit of Accounts

The internal audit of the Council's accounts has been satisfactorily completed and the papers sent to the external auditor. The accounts are now available for public inspection.
