**Parish Council News**  
**Notes from recent meetings**

**Chairman and Vice-Chairman**

Jonathan Wallwin was elected Chairman and John Mosley Vice-Chairman respectively for the coming year.

**Car Park – Church Street, Headon**

The Parish Council report in the last issue of Heads-Up said that Bassetlaw District Council had agreed that the Council can lease the car park to make improvements to increase the number of parking spaces and that we were hopeful that lease could be finalised in the very near future. The lease has still not been finalised because Bassetlaw insist that we pay them £350 + VAT for work undertaken in preparing the lease. In view of the fact that the car park is in need of improvements which the Parish Council is willing to pay for from earmarked reserves of millennium fund monies, the Council wrote to the Leader of the Council to ask him to waive these charges. The reply we received had obviously been written by the same person that drew up the lease and so the Council has written to him again saying that it hoped that he would be able to see the incongruence of expecting the Parish Council to pay the District Council a fee in addition to the real costs it would have to incur in improving a public asset for the benefit of the community and asking him to intervene in this matter and have the charge dropped.

**Speeding /Traffic Calming**

The application to the County Council's Local Improvement Scheme for a permanent Interactive Speed Sign (ISS) was been unsuccessful and we are told there are at least 25 locations with a higher priority and so it is highly unlikely that we will obtain funding in the foreseeable future. We have asked for the temporary ISS to be put back on Thorpe Street/Yew Tree Road but this time correctly installed so that drivers are able to see their speed displayed. Nottinghamshire County Council will be reminded of their pledge to install '30' painted markings on the roads in Headon.

**Bus Service**

Last year the bus service through the village was reduced and there are rumours that it is now going to be scrapped (or possibly replaced by a 'request only' service. The Council is concerned about the County Council withdrawing a service which some village residents rely on. The Council is also concerned that the only information we have has come from bus passengers and not from the County Council.

**Highways**

Roadsides breaking away at Thorpe Street, Headon and Westfields, Upton and potholes throughout the parish will be reported to County Council Highways. The Council has asked the County Council to cut the grass verges which restrict visibility at road junctions and the landowner to cut the hedge at Dog Kennel Hill as this has become a major hazard to road users. The public footpaths in the parish require inspection as many are overgrown.

**Brigg Lane**

The Council is still waiting to hear form the County Council about the bridge on Brigg Lane. In the meantime we have asked the County Council whether the lane (and Clover Close Lane) can be re-categorised as a bridleway which agricultural vehicles would be able to use for access.

**Planning Appeals**

Two appeals have been submitted to the Planning Inspectorate against decisions by Bassetlaw District Council to refuse planning permission. These are the application for outline permission for a dwelling on land off Askham Lane, Upton and the application to erect a 40m high wind turbine on land off Lady Well Lane, Headon.

**Audit of Accounts**

The Parish Council's accounts for the last year have been approved by the Council, the internal auditor did not raise any issues in his report and the paperwork has now been sent to the external auditor. If anyone wishes to inspect the accounts they can do so by contacting the Parish Clerk to make an appointment.

**Next Meeting**

The next meeting will be on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> July 2014 at 7.30pm at Headon Village Hall.
