## **Parish Council News**

### **Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 2nd March 2015**

#### **Parish Council Election**

The members' 4 year term of office ends in May this year and the 10 positions on the parish council will be up for election. The date of Election will be Thursday 7th May 2015, the election process will commence at the beginning of April with a 'Notice of Election' being published. It is anticipated that nominations will need to have been submitted by April 10th.

A parish council election will only apply if we have more nominations than places. If we have fewer nominations than places on the parish council, those nominated will (as long as they meet the criteria) automatically be elected onto the council. Any remaining vacancies will be thereafter advertised and filled by co-option.

#### **Parish Council Standing Orders**

The Parish Council's standing orders have been revised and approved by the council members at the meeting of 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2015. Copies are available on request.

#### **High Speed Broadband**

Cllr. B.Wielgus reported that the funds are now released and phase two of the rollout will follow. The villages are scheduled for October 2015 to March 2016.

#### **Bassetlaw DC Part Night Lighting Scheme (midnight to 5.30am switch off)**

The effectiveness and consequences of the lighting scheme has been under discussion and following analysis of the results of a survey of residents from all four villages it has been decided to ask the district council to re-light all the street lamps on Thorpe Street, Headon and to re-light some lamps at Upton (numbered 4,6,7, and 9, plus the one opposite Halfway Farm).

#### **Police**

PC Bailey was unable to attend the meeting but reported by email that there has been just one crime reported since the last meeting, 7th Feb - Greenspotts Lane, theft of a decorative lamp post.

#### **Speedwatch**

PC Bailey reported that the new Community Speedwatch vehicle and kit has now arrived and has been out a few times, including twice at Headon. It seems to have a positive effect on driving standards as the results will show. On the first outing they checked 60+ cars with the top speed being 32mph. When this programme rolls out to the community volunteers PC Bailey will let us know more.

Cllr. B.Wielgus reported that a temporary Interactive Speed Sign (ISS) will be installed between Headon and Upton in the summer months.

#### **Dog Fouling / Dog Control**

A consultation from Bassetlaw DC brought about a conversation on dog fouling as members highlighted issues and problem areas in the parish. It was decided to discuss this at more length at our April 13<sup>th</sup> parish council meeting. #### **Highways Reminder of Notification of Works**

7am 9<sup>th</sup> March to 8pm 13<sup>th</sup> March 2015 - Temporary prohibition of driving – Carriageway resurfacing works – Grove Road, Grove, from its junction with Wood Lane (South Leverton) for a distance of 1575m in a south westerly direction.

Alternative Route – Wood Lane, Forewood Lane, Town St, Cocking Lane, Retford Road, Hazelwood Lane, Lady Well Lane, Grove Road – and vice-versa.
