## **Parish Council News**

### **Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> October 2015**

#### **Parish Council Members**

Members are Jonathan Wallwin (chairman), David Landon (vice-chairman), Eric Briggs, Chris Holliland, Janet Landon, Beatrice McGlen, Alun McKiernon, John Mosley, Ben Wielgus and Fred Withers.

#### **Neighbourhood Plan**

A Neighbourhood Plan is a right for communities introduced through the Localism Act. Communities can shape development in their areas through the production of a plan. Several parishes in Bassetlaw are in the process of drawing up their own plans. In order for this parish council to give consideration for our parish, a presentation was given by Natalie Cockrell, Community Planner BDC. The stages of producing a plan were explained:

- the benefits of having an approved 15 year plan in place
- applying for funding
- agreeing the designated area and producing a statement
- appointing a steering group, advertising contact details
- the various consultation stages with the community and businesses
- involving the community, businesses, landowners, young residents – their views, development ideas, vision for the future
- consultation summary report
- environmental impact assessment / sustainability appraisal
- preparation and writing up
- production of a draft plan
- submission of the agreed draft plan to BDC
- modifications to the plan following feedback from BDC
- parish referendum to approve the plan
- adoption of the plan by BDC

A neighbourhood plan can take 18 months or more to complete. Further consideration will be given to this at the next parish council meeting, if anyone has any thoughts on this, please email the Parish Clerk at [headonpc@fsmail.net](mailto:headonpc@fsmail.net)

#### **Car Parking in Headon**

A design to improve the car park area on Church Street, Headon was previously submitted and approved by BDC. At the time, a lease of the land was offered but was rejected by the parish council due to the legal costs which it was said we would have to pay. As the parish council do not need to own or lease the land in order to make improvements, it was suggested that other avenues be investigated. District Cllr. T.Critchley offered to pursue this further.

**15/01041/FUL** - Land North East Of Mill Hill, Off Lady Well Lane, Headon - Install a Ground Mounted 50Kw Solar Panel Array

**15/01091/FUL** - Mill Hill Farm, Greenspotts Lane, Headon - Proposed Grain Store

**15/01126/HSE** - Longacres, Main Street, Upton - Erect Single Storey Rear Extension

**15/01071/HSE** - Oregon House, Drayton Road, Upton - Two Storey Extensions to Existing Dwelling House

#### **Grove Level Crossing**

A recent feasibility study by Hamer Associates looked into the possibility of level crossing closures nationwide, creating alternate routes for vehicles. The outcome of the study was that the idea would be shelved. Members agreed that the level crossing at Grove causes huge delays to traffic and emergency vehicles and the village would benefit greatly from its removal. District

Cllr. T.Critchley offered to obtain clarification initially from Network Rail with a view to lobbying them with valid reasons for closing the crossing.

### **Report a Road Problem**

More potholes and poor road surfaces were reported to the meeting, an ongoing problem we need to keep on top of.
