Parish Council News: Notes from recent meeting on Monday 1st September

Grove War Memorial – English Heritage Report & Consultation

The war memorial is owned by the residents of Grove and was purchased from public subscriptions. An inspection of the war memorial was carried out by English Heritage over the summer and a report has followed for consultation. As the area surrounding the war memorial is in poor condition and in need of renovation, the parish council has concerns that if the war memorial becomes a listed property, any future restoration or repair works could be hindered. This will be raised with English Heritage as part of the consultation response.

Police

A consultation took place through the summer months and we now have confirmation from Bassetlaw DC of the new property address.

Highways

The dangerous kerb at Dog Kennel Hill has been lowered during the summertime by Notts CC Highways. Overhanging trees and overgrown hedges on the highways in the parish are still a cause for concern, some cutting has been carried out through the summer months but the work has still not yet been completed.

Members of the public are encouraged to report any highways faults using the Notts County Council's Highways fault reporting online system which can be found at <http://www.nottinghamshire.gov.uk/travelling/roads/road-design-and-maintenance/report-road-problems/> You can use the website to report any highways issues, from a pothole to a broken street lamp.

Traffic Calming / Interactive Speed Signs

The request for a temporary ISS is still being chased up and we are on the list to receive it again but it's likely to be sometime next year. It was noted from the public forum that a one hour speed gun test had taken place during the recent road closure, Upton to Headon. More than half of the 101 cars were exceeding the speed limit, a large percentage travelling at dangerous speeds. The police have been given details.
