

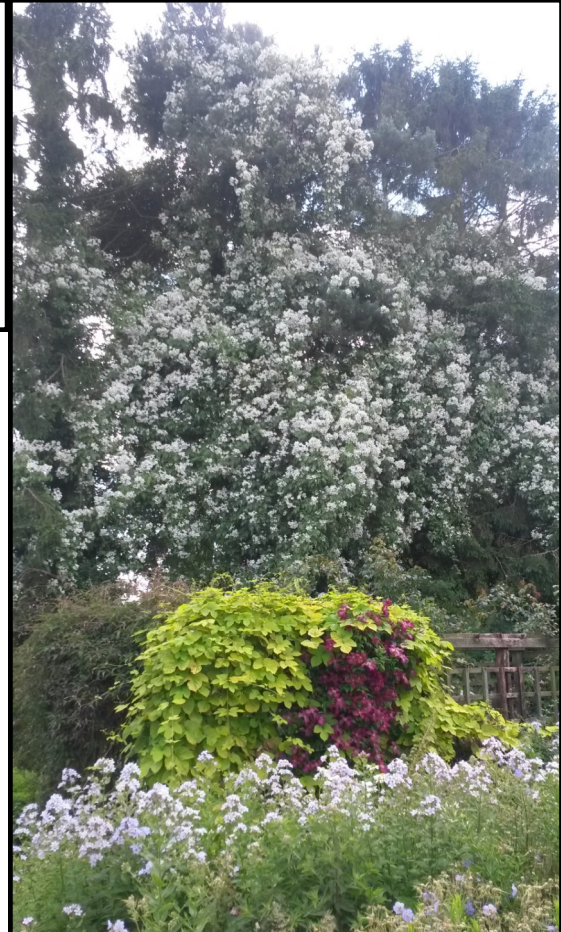

## **Parish Council News**

**Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 6th July 2015**

### **Parish Council Members**

Members are Jonathan Wallwin (chairman), David Landon (vice-chairman), Eric Briggs, Chris Holliland, Janet Landon, Beatrice McGlen, Alun McKiernon, John Mosley, Ben Wielgus and Fred Withers.

### **Welcome to our New Member**

This month we co-opted Mr Frederick Withers of Stokeham onto the parish council. Fred will represent Stokeham village along with Eric Briggs. If you have any issues or comments I'm sure they will be happy to help. We are now up to the full capacity of ten members and we have been congratulated by Bassetlaw District Council as apparently many other parish councils are struggling to get the same level of interest from their communities.

### **High Speed Broadband**

Cllr. B. Wielgus reported that there is news of the possibility of a third round of funding for the rollout project. He also reported that the road in Grove has been dug ready for the installation of cabling.

### **Dog Fouling**

The Bassetlaw DC Dog Warden, Nigel Barton has now put up signs in Headon. Please note that well bagged dog waste may be placed in the council litter bins.

### **Tree Preservation Orders**

The Consulting Tree Preservation Officer at Bassetlaw DC has responded to our concerns regarding the lack of consultation when considering the removal of TPOs in our parish - He says that there is no intention to make changes to the process for revoking TPOs. Bassetlaw DC and Notts CC have been making TPOs since the 1950s and there are over 350 TPOs throughout the District. Only around 20 have been revoked over that period and there are no new plans at this time to revoke any more.

### **East Midlands Ambulance Service**

Poor response times and an unreliable service from the ambulances in this area was discussed at the parish council meeting, some ambulance drivers are travelling great distances to reach the point of call. It was noted that an ambulance recently came all the way from Newark. These concerns will be raised with the EMAS.

### **Car Parking in Headon**

The need for public car parking at Headon has once again been highlighted and the use of the village hall car park was questioned. It is confirmed that the village hall car park is owned by the village hall for use by those attending the village hall.

The Church Street car park opposite the church is a public car park but several enquiries to the district council have resulted in no progress being made with regards making improvements to the area to accommodate more vehicles. This matter will once again be raised with the district council.

### **Next year's Budget**

The precept has remained the same for many years but this time consideration will be given as to whether or not to increase the precept to allow new projects to be funded.

### **Planning Application**
