Notes from the Parish Council meetings on 1st October and 5th November 2012

Co-option of a new member for Grove

Chris Holliland of Grove has been co-opted to fill the remaining vacancy and so, for the first time in quite a while, we now have a full complement of members!

Broadband Speed Improvements

Defra has approved £50k funding, subject to investigating a technical solution and surveying residents to confirm the level of demand for high speed broadband. Canvassing will take place shortly and your support is essential if we are to succeed in bringing high speed broadband to the villages. If anyone is interested in helping with the project, the canvassing, or can offer expertise, please do not hesitate to come forward.

Procedure for Including Items on the Agenda

Members of the public can raise any relevant issues during the 10 minute public forum prior to the start of the meeting proper. If you want an item included on the agenda you should contact a parish council member or the chairman, giving as much background information as possible. The agenda is published a week prior to the meeting and so an early request for an agenda item is essential. Because members of the public are not allowed (by law) to speak once the meeting has started, a preliminary chat with a councillor is essential.

Speeding Traffic

Following concerns raised by village residents about the speed of traffic on Yew Tree Road and Thorpe Street the Council has asked to be included in Community Speedwatch operations which are felt to have been effective in other villages in slowing traffic down. A number of village residents have volunteered to be trained in operating the speed gun.

Wind Turbines

The Council will ask Bassetlaw District Council about the effectiveness of the monitoring of noise levels at land off Lady Well Lane given that the turbines were switched off at certain times.

Car Park – Church Street, Headon

Bassetlaw District Council say it is not able to carry out improvement work and the Council will be looking at obtaining funding to make the improvements ourselves (increasing the parking area to accommodate more vehicles) but permission first has to be sought from the District Council.

Highways

A build up of leaves and debris on the parish roads and pavements, a street light not working at Grove, and overgrown hedges will be reported to the County Council Highways Department.

Grove War Memorial

Bassetlaw District Council, prompted by the War Memorials Trust, contacted the Council about the access to the Memorial. The Council looked into improving the access some years ago but the costs were prohibitive. However, with the centenary of the outbreak of WWI approaching, grants may be available and a site meeting will be arranged to discuss this further.

Hallcroft Tip

The design of the recycling centre at Retford was questioned as the ramps to the skips appear too steep for the elderly and infirm to use. The concerns have been raised with the County Council.

Proposed Concurrent Grant Reductions

Parish Councils across the District are organising a petition to try to force a debate at full council about plans to scrap the grant paid to Parish Councils to try to offset the cost of Parish Councils providing services that in Retford and Worksop are paid for out of the general council tax. Although our grant is small (£288 a year) the Council supports this initiative and members will be asking village residents to sign the petition.

Notice Boards

The village notice boards at Headon and Upton are to undergo refurbishment over the coming weeks. This will involve replacement glass at Upton and a new notice board at Headon.

Audit of Accounts

The Council's accounts have now been approved by the external auditor. The public may view the audit document by prior appointment with the Clerk.

Police Report

PC Bailey advised the October Council meeting that three crimes had been reported: a burglary at Grove, an attempted break in at Headon Camp and the theft of a tractor battery from Greenspotts Lane. He reported that metal thefts are decreasing and that turning off street lights during the night has not led to increases in crime. He was unable to attend the November meeting but advised that no crimes had been reported in the past month.
