Council Members

Councillor Vacancy

Highways

We are pleased to report that Upton fingerpost has been replaced. Bassetlaw DC has confirmed that the damaged 'Westfields' Street is to be repaired shortly.

Neighbourhood Plan

A successful consultation day was held on October 29th with 47 attendees. The six-week consultation period will end on 4th December. Speed Signage

The County Council is currently trialling a portable camera with Bothamsall Parish Council. They then plan to assess the success of the sign and the whole process around approving its installation. If the County Council is in favour of the outcome, we may then be able to move forward with our own purchase.

Village Lengthsman

Applications for the role are now closed. It was agreed to hold an interview on 18th November with a view to appoint shortly thereafter.

Attero Ltd Recycling Centre, Headon Camp Ind Estate

County Planning Dept. has not yet set a date for the committee meeting whilst they seek further information from the developer to determine the environmental impacts. Teresa Critchley has visited the site most days and raised all issues found with the County Planning Dept. It is hoped that the intrusive lighting shall be addressed shortly. She is also seeking clarification on whether the draft neighbourhood plan can have any effect on the planning application.

Police

Unfortunately, Bassetlaw District Commander Inspector Neil Bellamy has advised that PC Bailey's replacement PC Hayes has also decided to retire at the end of November along with PC Bailey. He has also confirmed that they are not in a position to immediately replace PC Hayes. On 15th November, at the Notts Association of Local Council's AGM, Teresa Critchley will present Notts Assistant Chief Constable Steve Cooper the paper and on-line petitions demanding a full replacement Police Constable. We shall also write to strongly object to the situation and to ask for timescales surrounding recruitment of a replacement. In the meantime, if you see any crime in action please dial 999 or 101 (if none urgent) to report it.

Riseholme

Following a lengthy discussion, the Council declared the matter closed and agreed that it had done all it could by writing a letter to A1 Housing.

Newsletter Funding

Following the cessation of the Headon 200 Club lottery, Headon Village Hall has funded the newsletter. As we have now expanded its coverage to include Grove and Stokeham, the Parish Council has now agreed to fund the annual running costs.

Consultation on the Future of Nottinghamshire Fire & Rescue Service

A public consultation is underway on the future shape and size of our Fire & Rescue Service in order to meet its financial constraints. The consultation proposes reducing the cover at Retford Fire Station to retained crews (part time) only during the hours 6pm to 8am. There are similar proposals put forward for Worksop and Mansfield, which would leave Newark as our closest full time station.
