He has remained one of the most influential figures in British traditional music, inspiring contemporaries such as Bob Dylan and Paul Simon and later artists such as Richard Thompson. All of this has culminated in him receiving a Lifetime Achievement Award in the 2014 BBC Radio 2 Folk Awards.

### **Defibrillators**

Following the installation of the 4 units, we have decided to grant the British Heart Foundation a one-off donation thanking them. We also offer thanks to the Retford Lions for the excellent training session they provided at the village hall recently. Next month the Council will consider arranging a second training session should there be enough interest from the 4 villages. J. Chapman Signwriters' of Retford have kindly offered their services to update the signage on the former Grove phone box to reflect its new use as a defibrillator kiosk.

### **Speed Signage**

Cllr Wielgus and Dist Cllr Critchley are investigating prices and options for portable electronic speed signs for the parish, they are also looking into the options of fixed signage.

### **Headon Car Park**

Cllr David Landon asked Dist Cllr Critchley to look into the possibility of the Parish Council adopting the A1 Housing Car-Park on Church Street.

### **Village Lengthsman**

We are investigating the pros and cons of employing a lengthsman who would be able to undertake various tasks around the 4 villages, from leaf clearance to litter picking, sign cleaning to verge strimming, there are lots of jobs the role could entail. If you have any ideas or suggestions, please email the clerk and he will pass them onto the Council.
