Notes from the Parish Council Meeting held on Monday 2nd October 2017

Council Members

Councillor Vacancy

Highways

We are continuing to encourage the County Council to renew the worn junction white lines at road junctions around Headon and Upton, chased the replacement Upton fingerpost. The damaged 'Westfields' Street sign and the blocked drains in Grove have been reported to Bassetlaw District Council.

Speed Signage

Cllr Wielgus recapped the history of the speed sign, costs now range from £1,800 to £2,400 depending on size and power source. Fixed signs come with 2 to 6-year warranties, mobile signs with a 1-year warranty. The lifespan of all signs is approximately 10 years with a 4 to 5-year life span on the battery. Mobile units tend to have a higher level of effectiveness. It is hoped that we can secure funding of around £2,000 from local major employers in the area before a purchase can be made.

Attero Ltd Recycling Centre, Headon Camp Ind Estate

Notts County Planning has not yet set a date for the committee meeting. The County Council is seeking further information from the developer to determine the environmental impacts. Once the committee date has been announced, a representative of the Parish Council may register to attend the meeting and speak for up to three minutes. Additionally, up to three members of the public, the District and County Cllrs may also register for three minutes each. The meeting will be open for the public to attend to the maximum capacity of the venue, which is 50 people. We will advise the date of the planning committee meeting in a future issue of the newsletter as soon as can. Cllr Harvey has agreed to attend the committee meeting to represent the Parish Council, she is keen to hear from members of the public their concerns and any evidence (particularly photo's dates/times) they have of smoke, dust around the site or of lorries visiting the site and driving through Nether Headon.

Whilst the abatement notice has been withdrawn, Amy Ogden, from Environmental Health is keen to hear from members of the public witnessing smoke emissions, please email amy.ogden@bassetlaw.gov.uk to provide details of dates and times.

Cllr Wielgus mentioned the draft Neighbourhood Plan which is currently under review by the steering group. That the Neighbourhood Plan draft will be looked at to see if the whole site of Headon Ind Estate could be earmarked as a potential residential site.

There were 2 crimes this month, both on the 18th September, Vehicle Damage at Headon Industrial Estate and an attempted burglary at Stokeham. Hedgehogs & Bonfires



It's the time of year when lots of people think about having a bonfire – whether it's to burn garden waste, to mark Bonfire Night or just to enjoy the dancing flames and sticky marshmallows. To mark this time of year the Wildlife Trust has issued its annual reminder to look out for hedgehogs.

To a hedgehog, a big pile of branches, leaves, bits of wood and other garden debris looks like the perfect place to spend the winter!

If you're planning a bonfire, the best way to avoid harming hedgehogs is to leave building your fire until as late as possible. That way, they won't have time to take up residence before you strike the match. But if you have to build your bonfire in advance, please check it for prickly guests by disturbing the base of the bonfire with a stick, so they can wake up and make their escape.

A compost heap is another common place for hedgehogs to hibernate, so if you have one, try to avoid turning it in the winter... hedgehogs don't like to be woken up!
