## Tour of Britain 2017

On Wednesday 6th September 120 of the world's top cyclists, including Britain's Geraint Thomas, will pass through Upton as they compete in the 4th stage of the Tour of Britain cycle race. As it winds its way around Nottinghamshire the race will leave Retford, turn off at Eaton and come through Gamston Woods, down Main Street in Upton on its way to East Drayton and the finish line at Newark.

The estimated time for the race to pass through Upton is 2.22pm, although this is obviously subject to change depending on how the race develops. Therefore there will be a small number of road closures in the area through a 'rolling road closure' system. This is where the race route, and junctions with access roads onto the route, are closed while the race passes through. The length of closure of the rolling road block depends upon how dispersed the riders are. Typically, the lead motorcycle instigating the closure is 15 minutes ahead of the lead rider. The closure then remains in place until all riders and race cars have passed through.

Within the overall race there are separate competitions for the best sprinter and climber, and the intermediate point for the Nottinghamshire stage 'King of the Mountains' is Gamston Woods. This vantage point is sure to be popular with cycling enthusiasts.

However if you are not about on the day then set your TV recorder as ITV4 is scheduling to cover every minute of the race.

### Highways

There were no issues reported this month. Our District Councillor is encouraging the County Council to renew the worn junction white lines at road junctions around Upton. ### Attero Ltd Recycling Centre, Headon Camp Ind Estate

We have received additional complaints from members of the public regards the site. There are concerns regarding lorries approaching the site from Retford and through Headon village, high levels of smoke emitting from the chimneys and saw dust billowing around the site. Dist Cllr Critchley and the clerk have written to Environmental Health to escalate these concerns and request a stop notice.

## **Planning Application: Headon Camp Industrial Estate**

A retrospective planning application has been made by Waste to Energy Assets Ltd for the 'Production of a Range of Wood Fuel Products and for the Importation and Processing of Wastes to Produce a Range of Recovered Fuel Products' at Headon Camp Industrial Estate. This process has already had a significant impact on neighbours in Nether Headon and may affect all of Headon when operating at full capacity.

## **Letter to the Editor: Headon Camp Recycling Centre.**

The next Parish Council meeting is on Monday, 4th September, at the village hall, at which time the planning application relating to the above facility will be discussed. Everyone is urged to attend the meeting, if possible, so that their opinions can be taken into account.

Please look up an article in the Daily Telegraph on 25th July, it is headlined "Pensioner shot in eye during protest against swarms of flies 'caused by recycling plant'". The recycling plant mentioned is Attero Recycling, situated in Rossington, and has a direct connection to the Headon Camp facility through its directors. This gives us an insight into what the future may hold for us if this is allowed to go ahead, and, once permission has been granted, it will be too late to object. We need to act now.
