Headon-cum-Upton, Grove & Stokeham Parish Council Summary of minutes from meeting on Monday 4 February 2019

Public Forum

Representatives for the planning application for the development of 1 house on the old car park at Grove Garden Centre spoke about their intention to resubmit the planning application.

One resident highlighted their desire to coordinate a group of people for a litter pick under the District Council's Spring Clean initiative. This will be advertised in the newsletter at a later date but if you want to preregister your interest please email headonpc@gmail.com and we'll pass on your interest.

Mr A Coltay, a resident, introduced himself and stated that he would be standing in the forthcoming election under the conservative banner.

Update on Councillor Vacancies

Mr N Greenhalgh was co-opted on to the Council to act as a new Councillor.

Resignation of the Clerk

The clerk's resignation was accepted, a locum clerk appointed and we're pleased to report that 3 people have applied. We're carrying out interviews in March to try to get the new clerk in post by the April meeting.

Setting of the precept

After last year's increase in the precept (the small part of the Council Tax bill that funds Parish Council activities), we agreed to keep it the same this year.

Council Finances

We agreed to outsource the payroll and accounts completion to a professional accountant for the current year with the possibility of extending it in future years. This frees up clerk and council time to focus on responding to resident needs and is likely to be more efficient.

Headon Camp

The Parish Council, Local Residents, Environmental Health, our District Councillor and Bassetlaw Planning met to discuss developments at Headon Camp and how to help manage concerns of local residents. The Council, who have new staff, are going to speak to the Camp to see what can be achieved.

Gamston Airport Development

There's an ongoing conversation about the local development plan and prospects of building thousands of homes in Gamston as part of a new village development to meet local housing needs. People have shared concerns about traffic and the loss of local businesses.

Parish Council Elections Thursday 2nd May 2019.

Elections for our Parish Council will take place on Thursday 2nd May. There are ten Councillor places available for the villages of Headon, Upton, Grove and Stokeham, but if fewer than, or only that number of people are interested then all will be automatically filled without an election being required to take place. Elections happen once every 4 years, although co-options onto the Council do happen between time if there are vacancies.

The Parish Council meets once a month usually on the first Monday of every month at Headon Village Hall throughout the year. It's a great chance to meet the neighbours and make a positive contribution to your community. Commitments are around 3 hours per month for meetings plus any time for projects that you choose to take on. If you are interested in becoming a Councillor then please do apply using the instructions on the village notice board or via
