Headon-cum-Upton, Grove and Stokeham Parish Council.

Brief notes from the recent Parish Council meeting on the 4th November 2019. The full minutes are displayed on the four parish noticeboards and at data.bassetlaw.gov.uk

A warm welcome was given to our new Co-opted Parish Councillor for Stokeham - Josh Burman.

As a result of a recent accident, it has been suggested that crash barriers are installed on the bend on Westfields Road just past the railway bridge. This has been reported to Nottinghamshire CC .

Nottinghamshire CC has completed verge grass cutting for 2019.

Cllr Harvey has received an estimate from Rampton Hospital for the manufacture of oak planters. Further consideration regarding the location, maintenance and numbers will be discussed.

Police report - there have been 50 calls, 17 are crimes and 20 calls to Rampton Hospital. 0 - burglary dwelling, 0 - burglary other than dwelling, 1 - criminal damage and 2 - theft others. Several villages have not had a single crime for the second month in a row.

District Councillor Coulte reported that he had written to the Chief Constable about weekend police cover. He further informed the meeting that he had attended meeting at Retford Town Hall, Rural Community Strategy for Bassetlaw in line with Government policy was discussed. He also talked about the failure of businesses within the first five years of being setup. Social isolation in rural communities is a current issue and young people leaving rural communities may result in an aged demographic for rural communities.

Cllr Mosley informed the meeting that recently the police had carried out door to door enquires regarding a dark green Ford Ka with false number plate driving around the parish.

Residents within the parish are encouraged to report issues themselves to the relevant providers using phone or the providers websites.

The Parish Council has agreed to insert into its Standing Orders a section relating to the use of secret ballots. They will be reserved for any planning applications that the council deems to warrant such a secret ballot.

Stokeham Church - £300 for grass cutting in the churchyard.

Headon Church - £300 for church yard fencing.

Grove Church - £300 for grass cutting in the churchyard.

Village Hall - £300 for the purchase of new picnic tables.

The draft budget for 2020/21 is well advanced in readiness for council consideration in December. Parish budget information to be received by the 10th February 2020 to Bassetlaw DC.

The date of the next Parish Council meeting is on Monday 2nd December 2019 at 19:30hr held at Headon Village Hall.

Scam & Nuisance Phone Calls and How to Block Them

Unfortunately there are a plethora of scam and nuisance phone calls going around. One of the latest scam calls, which some local villagers have received, is from an automated source stating that your internet connection has problems and will be shut down within the next four hours and you should press 1 to speak to your provider. On pressing 1 you are connected to a person who will ask you to turn on your computer so he can gain access. Under no circumstances should you do so, simply hang-up as their ultimate goal is to gain access to your bank account.

Calls like this can be blocked by using the BT Call Protect. After receiving a scam or nuisance call, just hang up and dial 1572. Follow some simple instructions to block calls from that source in the future. This will have to be done each time you receive a nuisance call, but it will stop you receiving from that number and in time you will build up a blacklist. This service is free to all BT home phone customers
