Issues discussed at the last Parish meeting included:

The parish has a new Lengthsman, Suzanne Ford, who will be keeping the four villages tidy, cutting grass, maintaining signs and reporting any road faults. If you see her working, please say hello.

The parish councillors have planted daffodils in all four villages. They are a variety native to England.

There were lots of road faults raised. Some of them related to the recent flooding in the wake of Storm Babet. These are being reported to Nottinghamshire County Council by the Clerk.

## **Bassetlaw Christmas Car Parking**

Visitors to Worksop and Retford will be able to take advantage of free afternoon parking again this year in all Bassetlaw District Council Car Parks (including the Priory Centre in Worksop) in the run up to Christmas and New Year.

Parking will be free after 2pm each day from Friday 1st December 2023 to Monday 1st January 2024 as the Council looks to encourage more people to shop locally and support our town centre businesses.

## **Retford Market Consultation**

Proposals to invest more than £400,000 in Retford's market are being put forward by Bassetlaw District Council as it seeks to protect the future of the town's historic market. The market has been a significant part of Retford's heritage since King Henry III granted its first charter in 1246, and now the Council is taking action to ensure the market retains this tradition, whilst being financially viable.

The Council is now asking all interested parties for their views on two proposals that could create a semi-permanent market, and provide additional trading opportunities through the historic Buttermarket, located in Retford Town Hall.
