Highways

Neighbourhood Plan

The six-week consultation period ended on 4th December. The Steering Group received around 10 emails and 20 comments at the open day. The views were mostly supportive. The steering group met earlier this month to discuss feedback received and to instruct the consultant to finalise the plan. Attero Ltd Recycling Centre, Headon Camp Ind Estate

County Planning have not yet set a date for the committee meeting whilst they seek further information from the developer to determine the environmental impacts. District Councillor Teresa Critchley has visited the site numerous times and raised all issues found with the County Planning Dept. Janet Askew and Teresa Critchley advised that there is a low level of awareness amongst our residents as to both the planning application, and the size and potential impact of it, should it be passed. The Parish Council agreed to hold a public meeting in January 2018, at which the plans would be explained and an open questions and answers session held. Teresa has kindly agreed to chair the meeting once a date has been arranged. 
