Headon- cum- Upton, Grove & Stokeham Parish Council

The Parish Council held its monthly meeting on Monday 3rd June and they were joined by 3 members of the public and our District Councilor, Anthony Coulteate.

The Public session gave residents the opportunity to raise questions about the bus service that used to run through to Retford on Saturdays, leaving Upton village at 7.30 am. This service still seems to be running at a bus arrives in Retford at 8.05 am but it no longer passes through Upton. It was believed that the bus was funded by Nottinghamshire Count Council and provided a useful and necessary service to the village. It was agreed that the Clerk would contact Marshalls in Sutton on Trent to establish what has happened and indeed ask if the service can be reinstated.

A further issue raised by a member of the public was to ask the Parish Council's Linesman to be mindful of the wildflowers when he is strimming the verges.

Cllr. Coulteate spoke to the Council about the importance of keeping a visible and accessible police presence in the villages as there has been some concern that the 12 week training course that our present police officer is engaged with means that the villages are without the liaison and support that is needed to address crime and create and maintain safe environments. Cllr. Coulteate said that he would continue to put pressure on Nottinghamshire Police to provide this essential service.

Cllr. Coulteate also gave a clear and detailed update on the situation at Headon camp. Cllr. Coulteate confirmed that the chimneys at the camp require and do not have planning permission; he explained that the enforcement team would take measures to close down activity on the site if proper permissions are not sought and granted.

The meeting continued with updates on issues from the previous meeting and Cllr. J Harvey assured members that planning for development and renovation at Glebe Farm is in the hands of Bassetlaw District Council and the owner's architect and that when this is submitted the council will consider the impact.

Other items covered included some highway problems that need reporting:

Headon: Bottom Woodbeck Farm- the bend on this road is particularly dangerous in winter and the Council requested Chevron signs to be erected.

Upton: Surface water from the road near to Corner Farm, is running into a nearby ditch but the drain isn't working; the water is therefore going into a field belonging to Oregon House.

Overhanging hedge Mainstreet Upton – Linesman to correct

Streetlights: No.1 Drayton Road – not working.

 No.3 outside the Homestead – on all the time and could be because of the overgrown trees.

 No.1 Nether Headon – not working.

Bridge at Lilac Farm needs some repair – Cllr. J. Harvey to resolve.

Yew tree road between Headon and Upton needs remedial work following resurfacing – the edge of the resurfacing is crumbling resulting in a significant drop at the side of the road.

Members looked at samples of new notice boards that could be installed in the villages and Cllr. J. Harvey informed members of the opportunity to have bespoke planters made for the villages and residents are invited to offer suggestions of where these could be sited.


