At the last Parish Council meeting on the 2nd June, the Parish Council resolved to have an ongoing maintenance contract for the defibrillators, which will be for the next 4 years.

Residents may have noticed the glass recycling bins that the Parish Council has instigated. We hope that you are finding them useful. If you haven't yet spotted these there is one next to the bus stop at Upton, one in the Village Hall car park at Headon, and one by the old telephone box in Grove. The bin for Stokeham will be delivered shortly and will be located next to the notice board.

The Parish Council continue to raise your concerns regarding local issues, to Highways (VIAEM) Nottinghamshire County Council and Bassetlaw District Council. Sadly, we don't always see immediate action but we do our best!

Parish Defibrillators

On Monday 16th June, the Parish Council welcomed the Retford Lions club who delivered a 'Lifesaving' training session including how to use a defibrillator. The event was well attended and extremely informative. We learnt what to do in an emergency, how to carry out CPR, the 'recovery position' together with an overview of how a defibrillator works. We would like to thank the Retford Lions Club for putting on this event free of charge for the local community.

The First Aid Training also reminded us that the first course of action upon finding someone unconscious and not breathing would be to call 999 or send someone to call 999: if you do this the person on the other end of the line will tell you where the nearest defibrillator is and will talk you through what you need to do.
