Parish Council News

Notes from the Annual Meeting held on 14th May 2018

Council members

Cllrs D Landon, B McGlen, B Weilgus, E Briggs, F Withers, J Landon, J Askew, J Mosley & J Harvey.

The District Councillor is Cllr T Critchley, and the County Councillor is Cllr J Ogle.

Election of Chairman & Vice-Chairman

Cllr. D Landon and Cllr. B McGlen were elected Chairman and Vice Chairman respectively.

Public Forum

Held for 10 minutes, during which questions were raised about the advertising of the Parish Council vacancy and about the Council's allocation of grants.

Vacancy – Parish Councillor

The District Council will as to be notified of the vacancy caused by the resignation of Cllr Wallwin. The Council agreed to send a letter of thanks to the Jonathan for his years of service to the community.

District Councillor Report.

DCllr Critchley gave a short report regarding a flooding issue at Grove and advised that ST Water had cleared and cleaned a number of drains that had resolved the issue.

Waste to Energy Ltd Recycling Centre – Environmental Health Matters.

It was reported that Air pollution monitors were to be installed at some point in the future. Photographs taken recently were to be forwarded to the Parish Council for onward transmission. A further concern was raised about smoke emanating from the Industrial Estate.

Wheelie bin stickers.

The Council authorised expenditure of £152 to allow this initiative to proceed subject to approval of the District Council.

Planning Application.

One application had been received relating to a small side extension at Gamston Wood House, Upton. No objection was raised.

Highways.

Members were concerned at the poor quality of road repairs (patching) which saw pot holes having to be repaired twice in only a seven to ten days period.

Damaged railings at Stokeham Dyke side were reported as needing attention.

Grants of £300 to each of the parochial church councils were approved
