Headon Churchyard Fence



Almost 150 years ago the vicar and parishioners of St Peter's church decided to raise funds to fence in the churchyard. They did a great job, and erected an attractive black iron fence. Some of this original fence is still in good condition, but in recent years many areas had become corroded and were falling apart. When various replacement options were considered by the PCC, it was decided that we should follow the example of our Victorian forebears and replace the worst parts with another iron fence. Hopefully this will last as long as the original!

With the help of various volunteers the new fence has been erected. Have you seen it? It looks very good indeed and has already been much admired. It hasn't been painted yet, but the black paint has been bought and awaits volunteers! If a number of people gave an hour or so each, it would soon be completed. Please contact John Mosley if you could help!

The PCC is very grateful to all the people who helped in this venture. John Mosley was the driving force and devoted many hours to its achievement. Sean Whelan, too, gave a great deal of time in co-ordinating the project, giving advice and providing transport. The removal of trees which had grown along the line of the fence was a major problem, until Nigel Greenhalgh volunteered to pull them out with his tractor and chains. Pat Thorpe also helped by sourcing the paint and giving advice. Without the generosity of these people this result could not have been achieved.

But that is not all, for thanks are also due to all of you who supported the Village Enhancement Group through the 200 Club. The fund has contributed most of the finance required, in keeping with its aims. So, a huge thank you goes to all concerned!
