Headon-cum-Upton, Grove & Stokeham Parish Council

Brief notes from the Parish Council meeting held on the 2nd September 2019. The full minutes are displayed on all of the parish noticeboards.

The new Parish Clerk Jim Blaik was welcome.

A discussion took place regarding the sourcing of planters for the parish.

Cllr. Anthony Coulte reported that the main crime areas are in Nottingham, Mansfield and Worksop and this is reflected in the allocation of police resources. One fundamental difference between urban and rural policing is the travel time associated with rural policing. Inspector Bellamy, Nottinghamshire Police places hope in the recent government announcement of an extra 20,000 police officers nationally however, this will involve a significant recruitment and training timescale. Any police office working in rural areas should be experienced in working in such an environment.

Bassetlaw BC have served a Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Section 333 notice on the Headon Camp. Bassetlaw BC will serve the Enforcement notice within the next two weeks. Once the notice is served, they have twenty eight days to respond. Any appeal against the notice can extend the process up to nine months.

The Parish Council have contacted Via regarding hedge maintenance at Grove Road, Upton and Askham Road. A fourteen day notice had previously been served under the 1980 Highway Act to cut a hedge at Main Street, Upton. The owner of the hedge has now cut the hedge.

Thanks was given to Cllr. John Mosley and his daughter-in-law for installing the defibrillators. It was recorded that the cost for the replacement pads for the defibrillator was £309.06. The parish defibrillators are located at:-

Headon - Village Hall

Upton - Main Street (side of Barley House)

Grove - Phone box

Stokeham - In the church entrance

Refurbishment of Grove War Memorial - request received for grant assistance. Further information has been requested.

Estimates are being sourced for the replacement of the four parish noticeboards.
