East Markham Apple Day is returning after a three-year break due to restrictions. On Sunday 2nd October from 10.00am to 4.00pm, in and around the Village Hall and adjacent Hampsall Heritage Orchard, there will be more than 300 varieties of apple and free apple tasting.

There will also be available a new apple recipe book, apple recipes including free tasting tables, pick-your-own apples at bargain prices, an Apple Advice Centre and dozens of stalls related to apples, fruit growing, general gardening and crafts. Refreshments (including cider) and entertainment will be available. Monies raised goes to local charities.

Plants for Pollinators:

October — Michaelmas Daisies

Daytime temperatures cool and daylight hours shorten by the time we reach October. As we approach winter bumblebee queens will leave their nest and start to feed up before winter hibernation and their worker entourage will quietly pass away. The same will happen with wasps so if you have a nest in your property this is the time to seal it up before a possible return next spring. Honeybees are different in that they don't hibernate, but become dormant in their hives feeding on their stores and await the warmer days of next spring.



All autumn flowering species of Michaelmas daisies are great for pollinators and bring cheerful late colour in the autumn garden. They need good soil and a sunny place to flower well. Michaelmas daisies will flower until the first sharp frosts in November and attract bees, hoverflies and butterflies providing essential nectar late on in the year.

Tour of Britain Returns to Upton



On Thursday 8th September the Tour of Britain bike race returned to Upton, in what turned out to be the last day of the race, which was cut short following the death of Queen Elizabeth II.
