Brief notes from Parish Council meeting held on 1st July 2019.

Headon Camp. An update was provided by the Chairman regarding an enforcement notice which was to be served on owners of the recycling operation at the Camp, who have not obtained the required planning permissions. The District Council representative has promised to provide further information on the progress of the notice, and hoped to be able to attend the next meeting in September to inform the council of the reaction to it by the company involved.

Concerns were raised at the lack of policing in the area, and it was noted that a new Chief Inspector has recently taken up his position. The Chairman has written to CI Riley to welcome him to his new post, and to invite him to attend a council meeting to discuss the current crime level, and the possibility of a new beat officer for our area.

Action is being taken to address the issue of overgrown hedges in Upton and on Grove Road, involving the District and County Councillors.

Further signage was requested for Stokeham, in an attempt to slow down traffic on the Cottam Road. A request was received for the temporary interactive speed sign to be deployed in Upton.

Replacement pads for our defibrillators have been purchased and have now been installed. A system is being created to prevent the use by date being missed in future, and the replacement of the battery when required.

It was reported that the clerk has resigned and that advertising would be placed to try to attract a replacement as soon as possible.


